Requirements:

- Must use color and label all the places Odysseus travels to
- Each location must have a brief summary of what happened there
- Must have a minimum of 6 images depicting 6 adventures of your choice
- You must trace Odysseus' travels and show the order in which he traveled
- The following locations must be labeled:
 - Troy
 - Land of the Lotus Eaters
 - Cyclopes
 - Aeolus' Island
 - Underworld
 - Circe
 - Sires
 - Scylla and Charybdis
 - Cattle of the sun god
 - Calypso
 - Phaeacia
 - Ithaca
