Roman Newspaper

Directions:

1. Using Chapters 13, 14, and 15, you need to write four articles for your Roman Newspaper. Each article should be about 100 words.
2. Three of the four articles need to be based on actual events from Roman History.
3. One of the four articles may be a tabloid type story. The article still needs to be about the Romans, but it may include completely fabricated information (aliens ate Caesar...).
4. You need to write the articles as if you were there and witnessed the event yourself. 1st person!
You need to add what you think about the events and happenings you are reporting on.

Components:

- **Rough Draft:** Write the rough draft of your four articles on a lined sheet of paper. We will be peer editing the articles.
- **Final Copy**
 - 11 x 17 Paper
 - **Pictures:** Each of your articles needs to have an accompanying **color** drawing of the event.
 - **Caption:** Each drawing needs a caption explaining what is happening in the picture.
 - **Headline:** You must create a HEADLINE for each article.
 - **Title:** You need to come up with a creative name for your newspaper.
